TO: All Member School FHSAA Principals, Representatives, and Athletic Directors

SUBJECT: **Classes Required for Student-Athletes**

IMPORTANT NOTE: THESE COURSES ARE REQUIRED ANNUALLY.

The FHSAA requires all **student-athletes** for all sports at all levels to complete the free NFHS “*Concussion in Sports*” the “*Sudden Cardiac Arrest*” and “*Heat Illness Prevention*” courses prior to the first practice of their sport **annually**.

COURSES MUST BE COMPLETED ON OR AFTER JUNE 1, 2018.

Each student must sign the EL2 form verifying completion. Student-athletes are required to print of the certificate of completion.

The following are instructions for ordering and completing the required courses:

STUDENT-ATHLETES – (you will need to make a profile as this is not associated with any school passwords or usernames)

NFHS “Concussion in Sports”, “Sudden Cardiac Arrest” and “Heat Illness Prevention”

Beginning a Course

Step 1: Go to **www.nfhslearn.com**.

Step 2: “**Sign In**” to your account using the email address and password you provided at time of registering for an nfhslearn account.

OR

If you do not have an account, “**Register**” for an account.

Step 3: Go to “**courses**”. Search for and select course (Concussion in Sports, Sudden Cardiac Arrest or Heat Illness Prevention”

Step 4: Click “**Order Course**” and go through the checkout process (even though it is free you still need to “purchase” it.

Step 5: From your “**Dashboard,**” click “**My Courses**”.

Step 6: Click “**Begin Course**” on the course you wish to take.

*Your course will launch on the same page of the web browser.

Click “Back to Dashboard**” when ready to exit course.

Be sure to print the certificate of completion at the end of the course and bring in to the Naples High School Athletic Department. Each school’s athletic department is required to keep a copy on file.
