\*The Florida Department of Education's Florida Inventory of School Houses (FISH) is the official source for school capacity. Permanent school capacity is the number of students that may be housed in a facility at any given time based upon the total number of existing permanent student stations. For the purposes of determining "available capacity": YES = schools with total enrollment projections less than 95% of permanent capacity and NO = schools with total enrollment projections greater than 95% of permanent capacity. However, applications will be accepted for all of the schools listed above due to the potential of enrollment fluctuations and the ability to accommodate individual grade level requests, subject to class size requirements, at the elementary level. The Capital Improvement Plan is the source of the enrollment projections.
