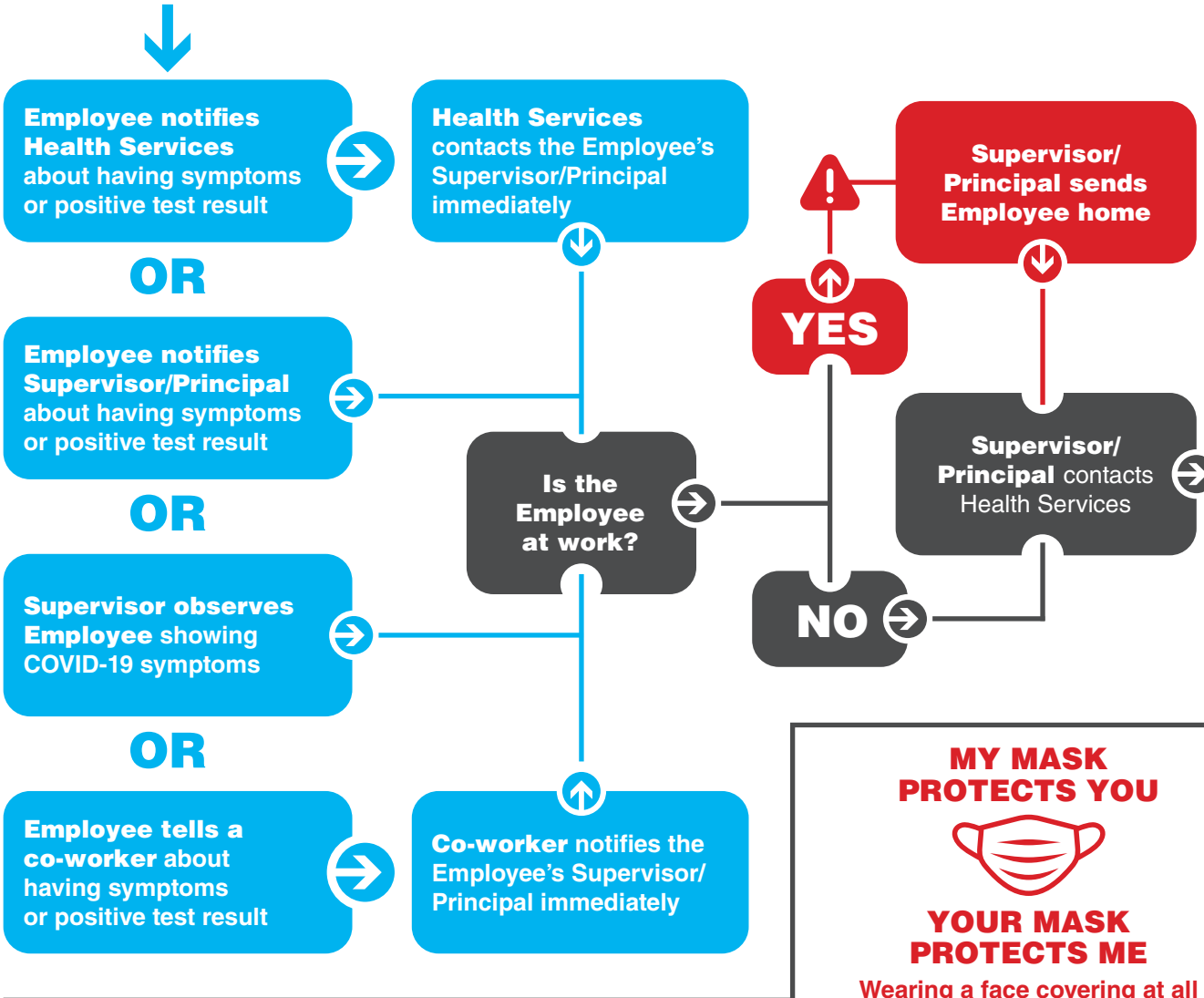

Wearing a face covering at all times when others are present and social distancing as much as possible may limit the need to self-quarantine and/or use leave!

Health Services will . . .

1 Contact Employee to discuss self-isolation and leave provisions

- If an employee has symptoms, employee will remain out of work for 10 days and at least 24 hours with no fever without fever-reducing medication and symptoms have improved
- If an employee tests positive and has no symptoms, employee will remain out of work for 10 days
- If an employee has a "close contact" with someone who has tested positive, the employee will remain out of work for 14 days and self-monitor

Qualifying reasons for leave related to COVID-19

An employee is entitled to take leave related to COVID-19 if the employee is unable to work, including unable to telework, because the employee:

1. is subject to a Federal, State, or local quarantine or isolation order related to COVID-19;
2. has been advised by a health care provider to self-quarantine related to COVID-19;
3. is experiencing COVID-19 symptoms and is seeing a medical diagnosis;
4. is caring for an individual subject to an order described in (1) or self-quarantining as described in (2);
5. is caring for his or her child whose school or place of care is closed (or child care provider is unavailable) due to COVID-19 related reasons; or
6. is experiencing any other substantially-similar condition specified by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services
