Dear Parent/Guardian,

Please be advised that the District's Student Progression Plan is reviewed and approved annually subject to local decisions any legislative updates. Beginning in the 2018-2019 school year a new policy was adopted and requires any former CCPS high school student who wants a standard high school diploma and is not enrolled in the Full-Time FLVS Public Program must re-enroll in their zoned high school for the last semester and accumulate a minimum of three (3) credits at their school. All students are required to enroll for their last semester in a District high school in order to receive a diploma and participate in high school graduation. The Student Progression Plan's new requirements are set forth as follows:

To receive a Collier County Public Schools (CCPS) high school diploma, and participate in the graduation ceremonies, student must enroll in a CCPS high school for the full term of the last semester of their senior year and earn a minimum of 3 credits.
