SUPERINTENDENT'S STUDENT ADVISORY COUNCIL

PURPOSE

The role of the Student Advisory Council is to provide high school students the opportunity to learn about the school district, provide input on a variety of initiatives, and participate in committees that help advise the Superintendent on decisions.

OBJECTIVES

The Student Advisory Council will use decision-making protocols to provide input on a range of District initiatives.

MEMBERSHIP

Participation in this year-long program is open to interested Collier County high school students. District personnel will review and select members yearly according to their completed application. Students selected to serve on the Student Advisory Council must adhere to the following expectations:

- Be a current Collier County Public Schools student
- Maintain a 2.75 GPA (unweighted)
- Attend all meetings (one unexcused absence maximum)
- Maintain CCPS Code of Student Conduct expectations

LEADERSHIP

The Executive Director for School Leadership will serve as the advisor. Once selected for the Student Advisory Council, student leadership roles will be established pertinent to their assigned task, including a Student Advisory Council Chair and potential subcommittee chairs.

MEETING SCHEDULE

Meetings will be held monthly for approximately two hours. The location of these meetings will vary between in-person and Webex. Subcommittee participation may require additional meetings based on the focus of the subcommittee topic or the assigned project.
