



Call for Artists-Grades 9-12

The vision for the “Centennial Public High School Student Art Contest” is to celebrate Collier County’s 100th Anniversary and to showcase artwork that highlights Collier County.

Collier County Government invites Collier County Public High School students in grades 9-12 to submit original artwork with the theme: Celebrating Collier County’s Centennial.

Artwork may include but is not limited to local landmarks, our unique natural environment, residents at work or play, the diverse culture of our residents, or historical scenes and figures.

Prizes

\$1,000 scholarship to be awarded to the winning student from each of the ten public high schools participating in the contest. An additional \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to the overall winner. A total of \$11,000 in scholarships is available and provided by Harmon-Meek Gallery.

Winning artwork may be featured in a variety of 2023 Centennial materials including, websites, social media sites, Collier Television, and displayed in the Board of County Commissioners Boardroom. The winning artist will be invited to and recognized at a Board of County Commissioners Meeting.

Submission Requirements

- All submissions must be original, two-dimensional, and no larger than 12 x 18.
- Artwork previously created is eligible for submission.
- No mats or frames.
- No offensive, controversial, obscene, profane, divisive, or sexually suggestive submissions will be accepted.
- No copyrighted images will be accepted.
- No student names on the front of the artwork.
- Acceptable forms of art media include, but are not limited to oils, colored pencils, tempera, gouache, acrylics, watercolors, graphite/pencil, pen/ink, photography, graphic design, pastel, batik, and printmaking.

Judging

Judging will be conducted by William Meek, Director Emeritus, Harmon-Meek Gallery, established in Naples in 1964.
