PUBLIC NOTICE

In light of the several Executive Orders issued by Governor DeSantis pertaining to the COVID-19 health emergency, and the directions of the Florida Commissioner of Education to close schools through May 1, 2020, the Regular School Board Meeting that was to be held at Everglades City School had to be canceled. Accordingly, a Special Meeting of the School Board will be held on April 21, 2020, at 4:00 p.m., for the Board to be able to address essential items in need of Board action.

In accordance with the Governor's Executive Order 20-52 and his Executive Order 20-69, and F.S. 120.54(5)(b)2, with the accompanying suspension of School Board quorum requirements, this meeting will be held virtually by means of communications media technology. Members of the public who want to attend the meeting virtually may do so in any one of the following three (3) ways: (1) Live streaming technology through the District's website (www.collierschools.com) by clicking on the Education Channel Live Stream link; (2) The Educational Channel which may be accessed on channel 99 through Comcast, CenturyLink, and Summit Broadband; and (3) By means of a live audio stream via phone technology (please dial 239-377-0007).

Persons who wish to make public comments on action items may do so by using the Speaker Registration Form which may be found on the School Board web page (www.collierschools.com/schoolboard). The form will be accessible with the posting of the meeting and must be submitted prior to noon on the day of the Special Board Meeting, Tuesday, April 21. Comments will be read into the record by a District staff member at the meeting itself. Each person's comments may not be more than three (3) minutes. Persons submitting such written comments should do so with the three-minute time limit in mind. There will be no general public comments at this meeting; only comments on items to be taken up by the Board for action will be accepted. All written comments received, though read into the record, will be preserved as part of the overall meeting record for public records purposes pursuant to F.S. 119.07.
