

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**Rule- 20/24 (Second Reading) Revision to the Code of Student Conduct**

Revisions are proposed to clarify, simplify language, and to include additional language needed, in connection with some areas of the *Code*, including but not limited to, the Matrix.

The general subject matter to be considered at the public hearing is the revision of School Board Policies as recommended by the Superintendent of Schools pursuant to Section 1001.49 (3), Florida Statutes. Members of the public will be provided with an opportunity to offer testimony and other evidence to the School Board concerning the revision of current School Board policies recommended by the Superintendent.
