Members of the public will be provided with an opportunity to offer testimony and other evidence to the School Board concerning the revision and retraction of current School Board policies and the adoption of any or all of those School Board policies recommended by the Superintendent. Written comments may be submitted for inclusion in the record of the hearing by addressing them to Dr. Leslie Ricciardelli, Superintendent of Schools, 5775 Osceola Trail, Naples, Florida 34109 before the public hearing.
