

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The general subject matter to be considered at the public hearing is the revision of current School Board policies and the adoption of new School Board policies as recommended by the Superintendent of Schools pursuant to Section 1001.49 (4), Florida Statutes. Members of the public will be provided with an opportunity to offer testimony and other evidence to the School Board concerning the revision and retraction of current School Board policies and the adoption of any or all of those School Board policies recommended by the Superintendent.
