**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
FOR ADOPTION, REVISION AND RETRACTION OF SCHOOL BOARD POLICIES**

The School Board of Collier County, Florida gives notice that it will hold a public hearing during the Regular School Board Meeting on November 12, 2024 at 4:30 p.m. at Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Administrative Center, located at 5775 Osceola Trail, Naples, FL 34109, which all persons are invited to attend. The general subject matter to be considered at the public hearing is the revision of current School Board policies and the adoption of new School Board policies as recommended by the Superintendent of Schools pursuant to Section 1001.49 (4), Florida Statutes. Members of the public will be provided with an opportunity to offer testimony and other evidence to the School Board concerning the revision and retraction of current School Board policies and the adoption of any or all of those School Board policies recommended by the Superintendent. Written comments may be submitted for inclusion in the record of the hearing by addressing them to Dr. Leslie Ricciardelli, Superintendent of Schools, 5775 Osceola Trail, Naples, Florida 34109 before the public hearing.

THE RECORD MUST INCLUDE THE TESTIMONY AND EVIDENCE UPON WHICH THE APPEAL IS TO BE BASED.
