1. Meeting Call to Order- Welcome

2. Attendance- Roll Call/ Determination of a Quorum

- a. SAC Members present: Jessica Campbell, Linda Furtado, Connie Ledbetter, Yuri Alonso, Jasmin Sanchez
- b. Others present: Melissa Stamper
- c. A quorum was present.

3. Call to order: A meeting of the AVE School Advisory Council was held in the Principal's Conference Room on April 11, 2017 at 8:30 AM. The meeting was called to order at 8:30 AM. Melissa Stamper will record minutes for this meeting.

4. New Business was shared

- a. The Locational Budget was shared. The remaining Teacher Lead of \$2,370.48 and additional Teacher Lead of \$1,379.07 money must be spent on student supplies by the end of the school year. SAC members suggested to spend this money on dry erase markers, whiteboards, planners, and copy paper. Members expressed that these are items that teachers have been requesting.
- b. SIP Funds – We have \$630.34 remaining in SIP funds after purchasing incentives for students. SAC agreed it would be best to save the funds for next year.
- c. SAC Planning- The times for SAC will remain the same for next year with half in the morning and half in the afternoon.
- d. Summer School – Dates, locations, transportation, and the calendar are all available on the District website.
- e. Title 1 Use of Funds (Basic, Parent Involvement and Migrant) – Items were reviewed that are included in the Title 1 Use of Funds, and input was asked for. Jessica Campbell reviewed that we have included supplies, guest teachers for instructional rounds, after school program, Licenses for ST Math, curriculum writing, and 15 laptops. The rationale for each item was also given. SAC members agreed with the items being purchased, and no input was given at this time.
- f. Title 1 School/Parent Compact – Melissa Stamper reviewed the compact with members and asked for input. Yuri suggested also looking at the SBPR survey for suggestions that could be included in the compact.
- g. Title 1 Parent Involvement Policy (PIP) – Melissa Stamper reviewed the PIP with members. The mission was reviewed, and major parent events were reviewed. Student Led Conferences were discussed, and members suggested having one of these events during an early release day.
- h. The Parent Involvement Budget was reviewed by Jessica Campbell. It was explained that these funds will be spent on food, supplies, trainings, and important parent documents. Additionally, funds will be spent on translators. Jessica asked for input on this budget, and none was given at this time.
- i. Kinder Round-Up/PK Stars on Tour- Kinder Round Up is on April 28th from 8:30-9:30. PK Stars on Tour is April 28th from 10:00-11:30. Preschool providers in our zone are invited with their students who will be 5 on or before September 1st and their PK teachers. They will tour Avalon classrooms, playground, related arts, media center, and the cafeteria. Transportation is provided by the preschool or parents. We want children and families to feel comfortable and excited about Avalon.
- j. Open Agenda - Connie Ledbetter said that the Volunteer Appreciation breakfast was a wonderful event and very appreciated by all who attended.
