5. New Business

- Testing Updates- Mrs. Campbell shared the Spring Assessment Schedule. All students participating in a computer-based or paper based test for the first time are required to participate in a practice-test session prior to testing. Grade 3 FSA ELA Reading is paper-based. Grades 4 & 5 FSA ELA Reading are computer-based. Grades 3-4 FSA Math are new computer based tests this year.
- PBS Data- Mrs. Campbell shared PBS evaluation data as well as results from the PBS Walk Through and PBIS Implementation Checklist. Avalon passed the District walk through. Data and staff feedback from families, staff and students are used to revise and update the PBIS action plan for school is an area for growth on the PBIS Implementation Checklist. Avalon is encouraging staff to write more positive referrals than regular referrals. Students are recognized for positive referrals on the News on Mondays and receive a positive referral and a Culver's Coin. Avalon recently did Coins for Kindness and it was well received by staff and students. The PBS committee at Avalon decided to have progressive rewards for filling up Kudos charts. 1st Smencil, 2nd Popcorn 3rd Class Choice.
- Facility Updates- Sand on the playgrounds will be removed this summer. The reconstruction of the wastewater pump station is still underway. The roof project is also on-going.
- School Improvement Funds- We have \$811.14 in SIP funds. Mrs. Campbell asked SAC how they think this should be spent. SAC brainstormed ideas for State Testing Pep Rally's. SAC agreed it would be best to buy testing pencils and incentives with these funds for students for a total of \$180.80.
- Parent Involvement Updates- Mrs. Campbell shared the remaining parent involvement activities this school year: Books & Breakfast March 21st, FSA Presentation to Parents March 30th, Math & Muffins May 1st, STEAM Night May 9th, and the Sun & Fun School-wide Event May 19th.
