1. Meeting Call to Order – Welcome

- c. A quorum was present.

3. Call to order: A meeting of the AVE School Advisory Council was held in the Conference Room on March 23, 2018 at 9:00 AM. The meeting was called to order at 9:08 AM. Melissa Stamper will record minutes for this meeting.

4. New Business was shared

- a. Approve Minutes from February – February minutes were distributed and members were given time to review them. Connie Ledbetter made a motion to approve the minutes. Jasmin Sanchez seconded the motion.
- b. Review Facility Updates – Scott Galloway reviewed the facility changes that will be happening. We will be putting additional fencing up at the park. The sand will be removed from the playground this summer and new recess equipment will be installed. The temporary roof has been installed, and the permanent roof will be completed soon. Locks are being updated so that they stayed locked, and a swipe card system is being installed in the front of the building.
- c. Review Testing Updates – Melissa Stamper reviewed upcoming testing. Testing windows this year are shorter than usual due to the hurricane. She reviewed testing dates that are coming up, and discussed how important it is for students to be here the day of testing.
- d. Review PBS Data – Natalie Hemmit reviewed PBS updates. We had our PBS walkthrough yesterday and we did really well receiving 47 out of 53 points. The representative from the district was impressed with the reward systems that are put in place throughout the school. We have significantly less referrals than we did last year.
- e. Review Quarterly Report – Jessica Campbell reviewed the progress that is being made toward school improvement goals. She also reviewed the new interventions that have been put into place in order to increase student achievement. We have targeted students to come to morning labs in order to increase achievement. Additionally, we have been doing instructional rounds with teachers in order to provide professional development and increase rigor in daily instruction.
- f. Review School Improvement Funds – Jessica Campbell reviewed the School Improvement Funds. The current balance is \$4,757.34, and we will be saving these funds for next school year. She also explained that our Title I funds are being cut for next year. The committee agrees that we should save the money for next year.
- g. Review Parent Involvement Updates – We had a wonderful turnout for our STEAM morning today. Parents were also provided with materials to take home in order to practice important skills. Additionally, we were able to provide training for parents in how to have student access Discovery Education from home. We also had a great turnout at our 2nd grade Dr. Seuss musical. We have a volunteer appreciation event coming up on April 12.
- h. Open Agenda – Lisa Ettlement mentioned that there is an Avalon family that is being forced to move because they can't afford their housing anymore. She explained that if anyone has any ideas about resources to please let her know. Connie Ledbetter also mentioned that she recently attended a hazardous weather event. She encouraged members to prepare now hurricane season.
