4. New Business was shared

- a. Approve Minutes from October – October minutes were distributed and members were given time to review them. Eduardo Mendez made a motion to approve the minutes. Linda Furtado seconded the motion.
- b. Review Healthy School Team Updates – Randee Ehrlich reviewed the purpose of the healthy school team at Avalon. She also shared a few healthy lifestyle tips.
