DISCUSSION	<p>CCPS has 24 NAF Academies, BC has 5, of which 4 are award winning and the final is expected to follow with eligible timing.</p> <p>*Finance - with Entrepreneurship goals, students are required to create a minimum viable product and proceed through research, cost, market comparisons, analysis, and production. Option to earn \$500 toward production of product (past winner created Bait Weights)</p> <p>*Health Sciences (achieving eligibl timing for awards) - focuses on human body systems including forensic data analysis and with 2nd/3rd year working to prepare the UF Bio Med - Lab Tech Certification. 3rd years will do cadaver labs at Arthrex.</p> <p>*Hospitality and Tourism - focuses on marketing, interview skills, creation of concepts through the MS Office programs and works to achieve the MS Suite Certification</p> <p>*Information Technology - internet and its workings, digital design, copyright laws, etc. They will work with the Art Show toward the end of Feb 2020.</p> <p>*Engineering - certifications for AutoDesk, work with reverse engineering, Habitat Home Design option and/or dream home design. Additional focus on principles of engineering including simulations now at BC and aerospace.</p>
