<p>AGENDA ITEM 2</p>	<p>NEW BUSINESS</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. September Testing Schedule - Mr. Hernandez passed out the schedule for Mr. Stanley, but will be updated based on school closings due to Hurricane Irma 2. Dress Code Enforcement – the changes to the dress code have been a PR nightmare. Mr. Hernandez said any future dress code changes would be brought to the SAC committee before any implementation. No actual changes were made to the dress code, rather, enforcement of existing district rules got stricter. This is the information provided to the SAC by Mrs. Zell Randall: CCPS Code of Student Conduct 2017-2018, Rule 11(5) http://www.collierschools.com/Page/4900 Intentionally altered clothing or unbuttoned and ill-fitted garments are not acceptable. Ill-fitted garments include but are not limited to garments that are too small so as to reflect immodesty, or too large so as to appear falling off the body. Clothing that exposes underwear or body parts in an indecent or vulgar manner or that disrupts the orderly learning envint is prohibited. Mesh or see through clothing may not be worn without other appropriate clothing underneath (FS1006.07 (2)(d)) Parents on the SAC committee spoke of complaints they had heard from other parents about the late notice of this new enforcement, as most school clothes shopping is done in the summer. Mr. Hernandez accepted responsibility for the poor roll out of the enforcement changes, and promised to work with SAC on any new changes. Mr. Dawes stated dress code and electronics were two of the biggest issues teachers faced with the students. Electronics discussion was tabled for another meeting. The committee discussed, led by Mr. Hernandez, the importance of dressing appropriately for success. 3. Recording secretary needed – It was decided to elect a new recording secretary after the SAC elections later this month 4. SAC Elections – These will be conducted on curriculum night during first period Monday, September 25th) Mrs. Crisci has graciously agreed to count the ballots with student representatives. 5.
