Ms. Steinmetz- Jackson going to fill in as Guest Teacher. • Title 1 funds were used for 6 teacher planning days. Dr. Phipps has given each grade level (K-5, ESE) a full day of planning to discuss strengths, ideas, things to work on, collaborate to better the grade level for both teachers and students. • Title 1 funds will be used to have Guest Teachers available so that our new teachers will be able to shadow other teachers to observe and learn. • Not sure if we will be a Title 1 next year, but there is an application and criteria, requirements, income base, to allow us to keep the status. If title 1 status is lost, all the extra money and teachers, instructional, resource math, and resource reading teacher would be lost and have to be incorporated back into the regular rotation of a teacher, not able to be an additional body. • Dr. Phipps asked for a vote to approve the School ballot for teachers that he presented to us, to vote on for A+ Money expenditures.
