Measurable, Action, Plan in Math, Science and ELA- Language Arts. Total Budget School received: \$373,388.40. Mrs. Griffin was hired to be the ELL Teacher, Buchanan remained in 2nd grade as a teacher since Mrs. Piggott retired as of October 15, 2024. Advertisement to go out regarding obtaining another Resource Teacher and if any \$\$ left over to get an ELL tutor. November will start to implement Full Day of Planning for all teachers in each grade level, SAC monies used to pay for food for the teachers since Title 1 money doesn't apply. All day subs for each grade will be available to allow these days of planning to occur. • Our MTSS Process – PM1 results are put into graphs against last year's PM3 results to determine where each child is at currently. Each teacher will then sit with Dr. Phipps to review each child and their progress (or decline) to determine if they need to be moved up or down to better suit their needs with their strengths and/or weaknesses. Direct Instruction "DI"- moves children around for 30minutes to give the students what they need. Old way was disruptive, and time consuming, new way helps incorporate the child into the classroom to get the full advantage of information. BCE is still an "A rated" school, though the numbers went down, gains will need to be made to get back to where we were.
