AGENDA ITEM 3	<p>QB2 data</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Used as a monitoring tool• 3-5 grades tested in Reading, Math, Writing, and Science• Data is used to drive instruction• Also look at Attendance of staff and students• K-5 iReady data (diagnostic testing done 3 times a year)• FSAA (IBI classes)- alternate assessment• VPK – monitored 3 times/year• Compare CES to District Average and there is a correlation for each student’s score to what they would potentially get on the FSA• Teachers can also see which standards a student needs to work on to improve• Look at whole school – grade level – class – student• Parent Question: Do charter schools also hve to participate in QB testing and how do we show comparison?<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Charter schools do not take QB tests, but do take the FSA

AGENDA ITEM 5 5:30pm-6:15pm	CCPS Virtual Symposium – Preparing Your Child To Be Life Ready! - <ul style="list-style-type: none"> SAC members viewed the CCPS virtual symposium Key points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 70% students go to college Have meaningful conversations with your child Have them do a service activity in the area they are thinking of pursuing for a future career Len Zaiser (business owner) emphasized the importance of teaching children communication skills (eye contact, oral and written communication, neat applications, don't look at your cell phone when talking to someone, firm hand shake and thank you notes), some ideas to help children get into their career: do internships, get involved, and be a part of advisory boards Cpl. Eggleston-Negron: CCSO You Can Do It All program for 5th grade girls entering 6th grade, teaches teamwork, self-esteem, kindness, CPR, self-defense, anti-bullying, and giving compliments; do a community service project together during the second session Allison Ferraro: discussed the different SEL strategies we use throughout the district, resources can be found on the CCPS district website
