Decrease level 1's and 2's by 3%. T.E.A.M. time is taking place across the building 8:30-9:00 focus is reading (below level, on level, enrichment). Placed students based on needs of students. Every staff member is working with groups during this time. Math 360 Lab has been setup to work on math skills.
