<p>AGENDA ITEM 2</p>	<p>Parent input 2024-2025 Use of Funds:</p> <p>Comprehensive Needs Assessment (CNA)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Our monies for this paid for our Math/Science coaches, resource teachers, etc. We say yes to this because it shows in our scores. Math was at 73%, ELA was 50%. Testing from last week from the district with a curriculum checkpoint. 4th grade is 5th in the district. 3rd grade is number 10 in the district. 5th grade is 19th in the district but we have most of our newcomers in 5th grade. 14 newcomers in the district but had to take the test. Science we were compatible with the district. We are the number one Title 1 school in Science. • Focus to close achievement gap in math, ELA, and science. • For the funding of the CNA – keep funding these positions to keep closing the achievement gap and to support all learners ESE, ELL, gifted, etc. <p>Title 1 Basic/ Título 1 Básico</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 7 schools were added to the Title 1 so this shifted the budget for all Title I schools. We didn't get more money – it was just divided. Every school got a budget cut. Title 1 funds are federal. GGE has a \$4900 deficit for the 24-25 school year. GGE will need to fund the Leader in Me membership. • Discussion and input provided to continue to support academic supports by funding academic coaches and resource teachers. <p>Parent Involvement</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We still want to build our parent involvement. We have money to fund some Saturday events for the parents to come in. • Suggestion was made to use a Saturday to train families on Leader on Me. • To increase parent involvement, choose Saturday based on 16 responses and begin with Leader in Me then build into ELA/Math/Science focus
