AGENDA ITEM 3	Review of SAC Budget: Schimper Funds: \$3,716 is available. Blanca Tanguma made a motion to use the Schimper Funds in the amount of \$425 to renew Tumbleweed Press for Media. Susan Shiveler seconded it to and it was approved unanimously.
AGENDA ITEM 4	The cost of our Scholastic Reading Counts renewal through this school year is \$774. Blanca Tanguma made a motion to use the Schimper Funds to pay for this program. Susan Shivler seconded it and it passed unanimously.

AGENDA ITEM 5	<p>School needs – Garden, Media Center (new books), volunteers(Fiddlers Creek) Mrs. Borowski presented the idea to convert the small playground to a raised bed garden for students. This will provide students with life skills incorporating planting, science, math, etc.</p> <p>We are very thankful for our partnership with Fiddlers Creek. This community is very supportive of MES and donates school supplies, holiday toys, and money for the school. This relationship between Fiddlers Creek and Manatee Elementary School is outstanding and a great role model. We are combining our efforts to challenge other communities within Collier County to connect with other Title One schools to support these schools.</p> <p>Many of our library/media books are outdated. We are looking into purchasing new ones.</p>
