WELCOME	Opening/Welcome – Dr. Mearsheimer welcomed our SAC/PTO parent leadership group and invited all to attend the 2 nd grade music/art show following this meeting.
APPROVAL OF MINUTES	Approval of October 2018 minutes - Lourdes Muina made a motion to approve. Beatriz Cuellar seconded the motion. Minutes were approved.
AGENDA ITEM 1	Dr. Mearsheimer shared information regarding our iReady school-wide goal and quarter 1 celebration. As a school, we achieved our goal of 70% pass rate on iReady lessons. Students were surprised with a special video announcement and impromptu celebration in the bus loop. New goals were established for quarter 2 for each class (maintain =>70% or increase by 3%).
AGENDA ITEM 2	Dr. Mearsheimer shared our quarter 1 benchmark data for grades 3-5. Grades 3 and 5 showed an increase in scores from this point last year in both ELA and Math while grade 4 decreased. When comparing cohort groups of students in grades 4 and 5, however, all scores increased.
AGENDA ITEM 3	SDAC and PTO/SAC district meeting updates – Lourdes Muina attended these as our Manatee representative. We will meet and determine topics to be shared at future SAC meetings.
AGENDA ITEM 4	SAC funds available – \$3,658 Funds requested for FETC conference – Dr. Mearsheimer requested funds to send teachers to the FETC technology conference in Orlando in January 2019. Teachers would be expected to share what they learned regarding specific utilization of technology to enhance student achievement with colleagues upon their return. Lourdes Muina made a motion to approve a maximum of \$3200 to support sending teachers to this conference. Blanca Tanguma seconded the motion. A maximum of \$3200 for sending teachers to this conference was approved.
