	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ <b>Student Council:</b> One representative from each 3rd, 4th and 5th grade class, elected by the students. Student councils work on spirit projects and service projects, and so far they are doing something the help animals in January. They are learning about Domestic Animal Services and the Conservancy Wild Animal Clinic. Then In May they are planning a surprise for the staff during Teacher Appreciation Week.</li> <li>➤ <b>Peer Mediation Program:</b> Fifth grade students trained in active listening and conflicts resolution skills. Student mediators working in pairs with two students in any grade level having a conflict or problem. A means for students to help their peers solve conflicts and learn peaceful ways to handle problems in the future. A program that can build a school culture of problem-solving using words.
