Additional COVID-19 Guidelines

Please know as our schools prepare to open for the 2021-22 school year this school year, the health and safety of our staff and students is paramount to our success going forward. Due to concerns related to COVID-19, the following changes and daily assurances have been developed in accordance with the Florida Department of Education.

Staff to Student Ratios

- One staff member to 15 students or less with social distancing guidelines in place
- Two staff members to up to 25 students in larger areas where social distancing remains possible
- students and staff may eat meals/snacks together while social distancing to the greatest extent possible (both in line and while seated)
- Groups may be in classroom settings with social distancing guidelines maintained throughout the day

Promote healthy hygiene practices including, but not limited to:

- The district will continue to social distance wherever possible, maximize classroom space, and plexiglass at service counters will remain in place
- Voluntary wearing of face masks will continue with the return to school for the 2021-2022 school year. However, masks are encouraged for those who are unvaccinated
- Disposable masks are available upon request
- Staff and students will continue to frequently wash hands
- Hand washing prior to eating snacks or meals
- Hand washing after each activity
- In the absence of soap, use available hand sanitizer stations
- Cover mouth/nose when coughing or sneezing

Child Arrival/Departure

- Restricting access to campus during before and after school hours will help us protect our students and staff from potential transmission
- Parents, guardians, and caregivers are not permitted inside the facilities
- Parents, guardians and caregivers ring doorbell and/or call SACC office
- Site Supervisor/Designee will escort the child to and from the gate

Program changes to further ensure safety

- Classrooms and facilities used by SACC services will be cleaned on a daily basis
- Child Care Enrollment Application Forms (fillable) online
