The TLEADS budget was the only one to change from last time to \$2437.73.</p> <p>2. A+ Money Funds Voting Approval A background on A+ funds was given to the SAC Committee. A committee was formed to disburse the A+ funds, representatives from different grade levels, instructional, non-instructional, VPK, etc. Plans A, B, & C were voted on by the staff, each plan distributes funds differently, and different staff members are added/eliminated. All staff members can vote on the plans except for the principal and assistant principal. The vote took place on December 6th. Plan “A” received 2 votes, Plan “B” received 38 votes, and plan “C” received 32 votes. SAC approved the A+ plan “B” that was voted on by the staff.
