5. Bring completed *Course Selection Sheet*, with you to your assigned registration time. Only students with their completed and signed Course Selection Sheet will be permitted to register at their assigned time. All other students will need to turn in sheets to Guidance by March 9, 2018. (Otherwise, courses will be selected for you.)

Schedule changes will be honored if one following criteria exists: (1) A student has passed a class in which he or she is enrolled; (2) Administrative action is necessary to balance classes; or (3) a student is inappropriately placed according to level of ability or test scores.
