



Dear Parents of a Grade 1 – 5 Student,

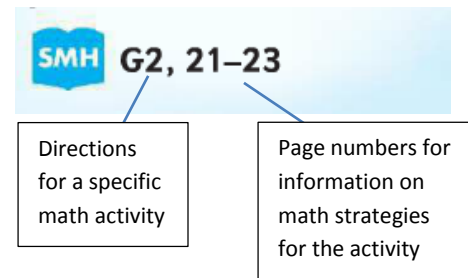
We would like to make you aware of a helpful math resource being provided to you and your child. Pearson SuccessNet offers the opportunity to also access the *Investigations* Student Math Handbook (SMH) in English and/or Spanish online. The material is presented at a high level of rigor as required by Florida’s Standards for Mathematics.

The Student Math Handbook is a tool that provides information for students and parents about important math words and ideas. **This resource is also helpful to remind students of the strategies they used in class while they are completing homework.** Some of the papers that students work on at school and at home may include the homework symbol (pictured below) and a note on the top right that briefly explains what we have been doing in class and provides a page number from the SMH that can be referenced for more information. Additionally, the SMH includes directions to the math games we have played in the classroom.

How to access *Investigations* Student Math Handbook:

1. Access your Internet browser
2. Enter the URL (site address) –
<http://angel.collierschools.com/default.asp>
3. Once in ANGEL, use the following information:

Username – your student’s six-digit student ID
 Password – Grades K – 2: 1
 Grades 3 – 5: the month and day of your
 student’s birthday, MMDD



4. Go to the area titled “CCPS Student Links” and click “Elementary School Student Resources.” Then, go to the “Online Resources” area and click “Pearson SuccessNet.”
5. Click on the *Investigations* Student Math Handbook to view the resource.

This can easily be found in the Parent Section of the Collier County Public Schools website.
