Sequence of Courses

- Competency 1 must be taken prior to Competency 2. Competencies 3 and 4 may be taken in any order.
- Competency 5 must be taken **after the completion of** Competencies 1 through 4 and includes a practicum observation.

CCPS Reading Endorsement Course Delivery Model

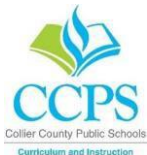
- In-person sessions on Saturdays with pre-course and post-course assignments in Canvas
- Job-embedded activities to meet the course indicators to be completed between Saturday sessions

Timeline

Competencies 1 - 5 are offered each semester

- Duration: four in-person Saturday sessions

Competency 1 is offered in the summer.

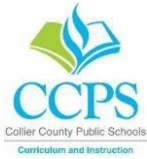
Competency 5: Demonstration of Accomplishment (60 MIP)

Sequence of Courses and Delivery Model

- Course 1: Competencies 1 & 2
 - Duration: one semester
 - WebEx meetings 4:30 pm – 6:00 pm twice weekly
 - Job-embedded activities to meet the course indicators
 - Participants must attend all sessions and make a commitment to complete the entire Reading Endorsement Pathway
- Course 2: Competencies 3, 4, & 5
 - Duration: one semester
 - WebEx meetings 4:30 pm – 6:00 pm twice weekly
 - Job-embedded activities to meet the course indicators
 - Participants must attend all sessions and make a commitment to complete the entire Reading Endorsement Pathway
- Teachers must be eligible to take the competencies included in the course (EX: To participate in Course 1, teachers may NOT have taken either Comp 1 or Comp 2 prior to enrolling in this course)

Timeline

Begin Competency 1 early in the Fall Semester and continue through Competency 5 with completion in May. (Approximately 10 months)

Employee Access

OPTION 1

- Step 1: Click to access your transcript
- Step 2: You will be required to sign in with your district credentials in order to view your transcript

You must be using Google Chrome, Safari or FireFox as your internet browser



OPTION 2

- Step 1: Text the word **TRANSCRIPT** to (239) 208-0970 from any mobile device, with text capability
- Step 2: You will then receive a reply with a unique link, which will direct you to your transcript
- Step 3: You will be required to sign in with your district credentials in order to view your transcript

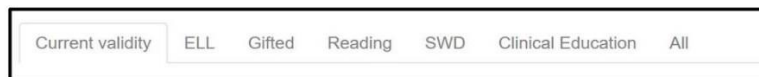


Once you are signed into the **new** portal, you will click on the "Staff" dropdown menu, on the left hand side of the screen. Then select "My Certifications"



NAVIGATING THROUGH YOUR TRANSCRIPT

- The first tab (Current Validity) will display only those trainings you have completed within your current validity period. These are the points that you can use for your upcoming professional certificate renewal.
- If you would like a breakdown of your points, you can toggle between the various categories, to narrow down your endorsement/requirement areas.
- The "ALL" button displays all trainings completed, regardless of date and current validity period.



- If you would like a printable copy of your transcript, you can also click on the .PDF button. This will generate your transcript as a .pdf file that you can not only print but save as well.
- Please keep in mind that if you do not see your points for a recent training, they have not been processed yet. The training coordinator has two weeks from the date of completion to turn in all documents and sign-in sheets. Once we receive the completion documentation, your points will be awarded within ten (10) business days.
