<p style="text-align: center;">AGENDA ITEM 2</p>	<p>SIP Updates</p> <p>Melissa Alamo discussed the School Improvement Updates by June 1, 2021.</p> <p>1st Goal- Increasing ELL FSA results by 3%.</p> <p>There was a decrease for 61% to 52% in ELA. Goal to increase to 55%.</p> <p>2nd Goal- Increasing ELA FSA results by 3%.</p> <p>Students gains are at 59% and goal increase to 62%.</p> <p>3rd Goal- Increasing Science FSA results by 3%.</p> <p>Student gains are at 77%, and goal increase to 80%.</p> <p>To achieve goals:</p> <p>Reviewing the FSA data and making progress in these areas. Assessing Quarterly Benchmark scores and address gaps in understanding.</p> <p>Improvement will begin with targeted instruction, Academic Mentors/SEL Coach, iReady Diagnostic Assessments, Standard Mastery testing, and ELA Quarterly Benchmark Assessments.</p> <p>To achieve goals, students will participate in targeted instructional groups. Staff will support specific areas that students need to work on. Teachers will utilize research-based intervention material and create small student groups based off proficiency levels to enhance learning.</p> <p>Teachers will establish vertical committees that will meet monthly.</p> <p>Newsletters will be sent out to share findings with all staff at PME.</p>

<p>AGENDA ITEM 4</p>	<p>QB3 Information</p> <p>Melissa Alamo announced that today March 9, 2021 was the first day of computer based ELA testing for 3rd, 4th and 5th grade.</p> <p>March 10, 2021 - 4th grade students will have Math testing via computer.</p> <p>March 11, 2021 - 3rd and 5th grade students will have Math testing via computer.</p> <p>March 22, 2021 - 5th grade students will have Science testing via scantron.</p> <p>Students will have 45-60 minutes for testing, but will be allowed extra time for completion.</p> <p>Dr. Malik-Beltran asked the question - If the FSA testing is conducted on paper, why is the QB3 testing on the computer?</p> <p>Melissa Alamo answered - It is done to monitor progress. Students will be allowed to have scratch paper during testing.</p>
