SOCIAL STUDIES HONORS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Teacher Recommendation • A or B in current Social Studies course • FSA Reading was 4 or 5 (Level 3 if applicable) • Motivated, participatory, responsible
WORLD LANGUAGES HONORS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A or B in World Language Year 2
JROTC	JROTC Cadets wear uniforms twice a month. While in uniform, military grooming standards apply (proper haircut/hairstyle, males: clean shaven in uniform with no visible piercings or earrings)
NAF ACADEMIES & CTE COURSES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • C or higher in current Academy or CTE course • Each Academy and CTE course sequence has its own unique set of safety expectations that must be followed and skills/knowledge that must be mastered in order to be successful at the next level. Attendance and classroom behavior will be considered when making a recommendation.
ELECTIVE SEQUENCE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • C or higher in current Elective Sequence • Each Elective Sequence has its own unique set of learning, attendance, and behavior expectations that must be met. These elements will be considered when making a recommendation.
Career Research/ Decision Making & Critical Thinking	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Elective course assigned to students in need of academic support
