Tops

Polo Style Shirts

- Any SINGLE(1) colored solid shirt
- 2 or 3 button shirts only, starting from the collar
- Short sleeve or long sleeve
- 3 inches below waist of pants
- Shirt length no longer than fingertips (arms at sides)
- Tucked in (optional)
- Logos are permitted if it is 2" or smaller
(exception-option to wear school sanctioned logo)
- Spirit t-shirts (on identified spirit days only)

Outerwear

- Any SINGLE(1) colored solid outerwear only
- Polo shirts must be visible beneath the outerwear
- Logos are permitted if it is 2" or smaller
(exception-option to wear school sanctioned logo)
- Option to wear OMS sanctioned logo
- No prints, stripes, plaids or any other design are to be worn

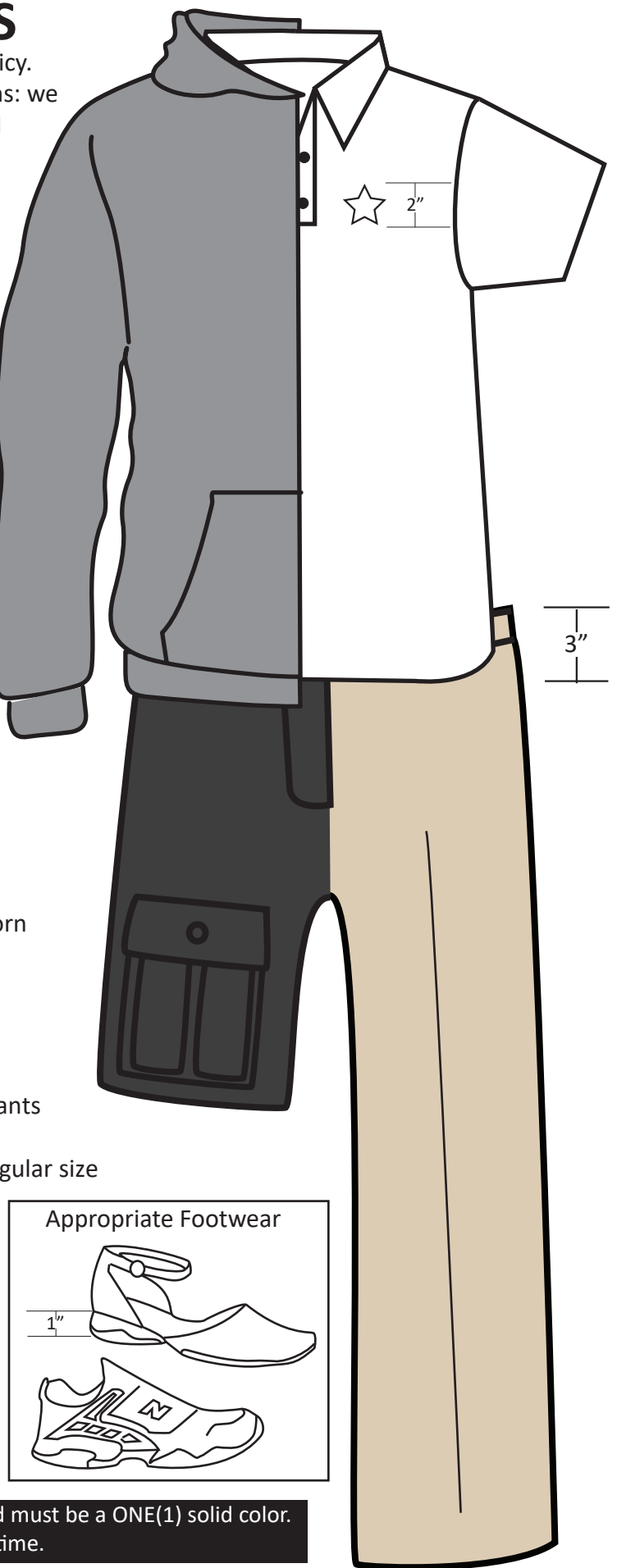
Bottoms

SINGLE(1) colored solid Pants, Jeans, or Shorts

- Long pants that sit at waist
- No leggings, stretchies or jeggings
- No athletic/sport-style shorts, no sweat/warm-up style pants
- Knee length shorts/skortis that sit at waist
- No more than one size larger or smaller than student's regular size
- Belts are optional
- No skirts
- No frayed edges or holes of any kind

Footwear

- Closed toe, closed heel
- No heel height greater than one inch
- Original shoelaces must coordinate with shoe
- No flip flops
- Socks can be solid color or print



All clothing must be in good condition, without tears or rips and must be a ONE(1) solid color. No prints, stripes or plaids or any design are to be worn at any time.

*** Logos such as sports teams, prints with flowers, strips, etc. are acceptable. Mask may not contain any political or inflammatory logos. Masks shall not interfere with the educational process in the reasonable discretion of the principal or designee.**
