



Summer Learning Activities

The purpose of this flyer is to provide families with high quality Pre-K activities and resources in order to support and reinforce classroom experiences during summer learning. This will help children to keep up their current skills and be Kindergarten ready for next school year!

Academic Development

Basic Skills

- Memorize first and last name, age, birthdate, telephone number, address, lunch number(student ID), parents' first and last names
- Practice following basic 2 to 3 step directions such as go to your room, get your shoes and bring them to me
- Complete simple chores such as setting the table, cleaning up toys, sorting laundry, making the bed
- Practice taking turns and sharing materials

Literacy, Language, Math

- Recite Nursery Rhymes & play rhyming games
- Play "I Spy" encourage your child to be descriptive when giving clues
- Engage in pretend play
- Read or listen to books, talk about the pictures, ask questions about the story "What do you think?" or "How would you feel?"
- Have your child retell a story, share their favorite part of a story, tell their own story
- Practice naming upper and lowercase letters and letter sounds
- Practice counting to 31
- Practice counting up to 15 objects
- Practice drawing shapes, writing first name, letters and numbers 1-10

Physical Development

Large Muscle Activities

- Engage in games that require your child to hop, run and jump, such as Simon Says, Hopscotch, Obstacle Course
- Balance activities: standing on 1 foot, hopping, walking backwards, walking on a line
- Bouncing and catching a tossed ball
- Play child created games, encourage your child to describe what to do and the game rules

Small Muscle Activities

- Puzzles, Legos, blocks
- Scissor cutting (cut simple shapes, pictures from boxes, pictures from grocery store ads)
- Drawing pictures, shapes, letters and numbers holding the writing tool correctly
- Practice independent undressing and dressing (play "dress-up" using dolls/stuffed animals)
- Practice tying shoes, opening/closing fasteners such as buttons, zippers, snaps
- Practice independence in opening containers, removing plastic bottle caps, wrap on straws, and pull-tab tops found on yogurt, pudding, fruit containers

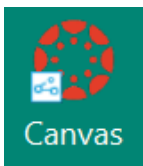

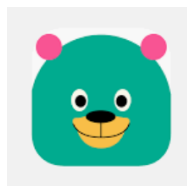
