



**2016-2017 Cambridge Advanced International Certification Examination  
(AICE) Test Results**

The Cambridge Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) Diploma is an international curriculum and examination system that emphasizes the value of broad and balanced study. Cambridge International Examinations are part of Cambridge Assessment, a department of the University of Cambridge. These advanced courses are designed to unlock a learner's potential by helping students develop an informed curiosity and a lasting passion for learning. Cambridge AICE assessments provide students with international qualifications which are recognized by the world's best universities and employers, supporting students with increased College and Career Readiness.

Every year, nearly a million students from 10,000 schools in 160 countries prepare for their future with an international education from Cambridge.

The AICE results are provided in the attached tables. Overall 75% of our students passed the AICE exams in 2017, an increase from 70% in 2016.

Some highlights of the AICE results are as follows:

- **Table 1a shows that a total of 2,520 students took 3,582 AICE exams in 2017 as compared to 1,702 students who took 2,646 exams in 2016.**
- **Table 1b shows the distribution of students taking the AICE exams across tested areas. The following assessments reflect pass rates over 90%: Global Research Perspectives (97%), Media Studies (92%), and Spanish Language (97%).**
- **Table 1c shows that Gulf Coast High School has the largest numbers of exams taken (769) and exams passed (564), while Lely High School has the highest passing percentage (90%).**
