

## Virtual Instruction Program (VIP)

**Open Enrollment period for full time students is open 4/12/2020 through 7/12/2020 for semester 1 of 2020-2021 school year.**

**Virtual Instruction Program (VIP)** provides eligible students with a high-quality, full time or part time, 180-day online instruction in grades K-12. All instructors are Florida certified teachers and are employed by the approved, contracted content providers.



### Who is eligible to attend?

Students must meet one of these eligibility requirements:

- The student spent the prior year in attendance in a Florida Public School;
- The student has a sibling who is currently enrolled in a Virtual Instruction Program;
- The student is entering kindergarten or the first grade;
- The student is a dependent of a member of the military who was transferred in the last 12 months; OR
- The student is eligible to enter grades 2 through 5 and is enrolled full-time in a school district virtual instruction program, virtual charter school, or the Florida Virtual School.

**If your child can say “yes” to each of the following statements, then virtual school may be right for your child.**

- Taking into consideration my personal, academic work, and extracurricular activities (clubs, sports, etc.), I will be able to devote as much or more time to my online class, as I do my traditional studies.
- I am comfortable using the internet as a means of communication and research.
- I am able to learn and apply new software applications.
- I am able to prioritize tasks, organize assignments, and complete assigned work within a deadline.
- I believe my reading, writing, and communication abilities are above average.
- I prefer to work alone on assignments.
- I learn best when I read the directions, rather than an instructor lecturing and giving verbal explanations.

Students are eligible to receive a computer, monitor, printer and/or reimbursement for internet services if a student qualifies for free or reduced-price school lunch under the National School Lunch Act, or who is on direct certification list (for services including, but not limited to, food stamps, Medicaid, welfare, unemployment, etc.)
