Helpful Tips for Dual Enrollment

Are You Eligible?

- 3.0 unweighted GPA
- eligible test scores:
 - Accuplacer (will be available to take at BCHS in fall and in spring): Reading 256, Writing 253, Math 261/263 (Math score will determine level of math placement)
 - SAT: Reading 24, Writing 25, Math 24/28.5
 - ACT: Reading 19, Writing 17, Math 19/23
 - PERT: Reading 106, Writing 103, Math 114/123
- Grade 10 and under: must have minimum 5 high school credits in core education courses completed and two letters of recommendation
- All dual enrollment students must maintain high school and college GPA of 2.0

Registration Steps

- Use the [FSW Dual Enrollment Checklist](#).
- Apply.
- Submit test scores.
- Complete Accelerated Pathways Orientation.
- View course selection when available - see school counselor to make sure you are taking classes that meet graduation requirements.
- Register through the Accelerated Pathways Form.
