

Elementary(K-5) Program 2022-2023

- eCollier Virtual Academy, part of the CCPS tradition of excellence as an A-rated school district, is a full-time virtual learning option with local Collier County Public Schools teachers. eCollier Virtual Academy Elementary School offers a full complement of courses, school counseling support, and flexibility. Students and families must commit to at least one semester at eCollier Academy for continuity of programming.

Elementary school students will have one assigned FLVS teacher per grade level as well as elective teachers. Students will complete self-paced lessons and will be required attend weekly live synchronous lessons for all state tested subject areas. Students must be enrolled in all grade level courses which coincide with courses that are grade-level appropriate based on the CCPS Student Progression Plan.

eCollier Virtual Academy Elementary School students will use one student learning platform for their courses. The learning management platform is ***FLVS VSA Educator***.

Students are required to complete a minimum of 25 hours per week of virtual learning or 6% progress per course per week. This model allows students the flexibility to complete the lessons and assignments outside of the traditional bell times for their grade level.

- 4 to 6 hours per course weekly
- 2 to 4 assignments per course per week

Parent Engagement

- It is recommended that parent's partner with their child's FLVS teachers, as a learning coach or guide – this is an average commitment of up to 2 hours per day, depending on the student. Parents can support learning by assisting with the following:
 - Monitor student daily
 - Maintain weekly progress
 - Ensure content mastery
 - Help with course navigation

All eCollier Virtual Academy K-5 students are to maintain the CCPS and the FLVS weekly pacing guide requirements per course and grade level. FLVS Teachers will provide guidance on pacing to parents.
