Literacy Updates- Jessica Rickard Literacy TLC Reading Counts is where students earn points by reading books The Sunshine State Young Reading Award (“SSYRA”) is a Florida group of librarians . Junior Level K-2nd grade, then 3th-5th grades, and 6th- 8th grade. There is a high school level called Team Reads, which we do not have yet. In SSYRA there are Brag Tags, which kids can earn and display on their school bags. Canvas has an online program called badger, which also has virtual Brag Tags. There are badges for Reading Counts points. Also recognition for Star Student of the Week for positive behaviors. All this to reenforce literacy and positive behaviors. The Canvas Badger Brag Tags have not been rolled out yet. Under Canvas each student’s progress is visible, but the student’s names are cloaked with animal names. March Madness will promote reading and maybe pizza parties, also visits by authors, one is a Naples own Heather Hinkle. We want to make sure the kids have access to books from the public libraries also. Nov 6th Nov 19th is the virtual 360 degree Scholastic Book Fair, ECA will receive 25% of proceeds from this book fair.</p>
