Naples High School Student Parking Regulations 2021-22

Students who violate <u>parking rules</u> or <u>Student Code of Conduct</u>, may receive a ticket and may ultimately lose their decal and permission to park on campus. *Students park at their own risk*. Naples High School and the Collier County School District take no responsibility for loss or damage of personal property. <u>Students must follow the regulations below at all times to remain in good standing as a student driver at Naples High School</u>. Students must satisfy any outstanding obligations before purchasing a decal.

STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

- > Cell phone use is prohibited while operating any motor vehicle
- > Display decal on the rear view mirror with spot number facing outward
- Students may not have leave campus without written permission from a parent.
- Students may not have excessive tardies.
- > Obey the speed limit on campus, 10 mph
- Park in your assigned parking space only
- After parking, always lock your vehicle and leave valuables at home
- > Leave the parking lot and move to class immediately
- > Stay out of the parking lot during the school day (Exceptions: Students must be escorted by staff member or have office pass.)
- ➤ Keep vehicle free of any bumper stickers, decals, etc. that include profanity, sexual innuendo, non-American flag symbols, and/or reference to drugs or alcohol (CCPS Code of Student Conduct, Rules 18, 24, 30 & 32)
- > Keep volume of the sound systems low while on campus
- Report lost or stolen decals immediately. Replacement decals cost \$20

If you lose your parking privileges, you will be unable to reapply for at least one month. Your name will go the bottom of the waiting list. Parking violations include but are not limited to the infractions listed below. The monies collected fund scholarships for graduating seniors and supplies for the PRO shop. **Repeated violations may result in permanent loss of parking privileges.**

PARKING VIOLATIONS

- Cell phone usage while operating a vehicle on campus*
- Parking in undesignated spaces in the student parking lot
- Parking in the staff parking lots or other unauthorized areas*
- Blocking an exit or other cars*
- ❖ Speeding, limit is 10 MPH
- Reckless driving including unnecessary horn blowing, disrespectful actions from behind the wheel, etc.
- Improper placement of decal on car
- Present in parking lot at unauthorized times without permission
- Transfer of a decal to another student is prohibited.
- Forgery of a decal
- Other serious infractions

*These infractions will result in immediate loss of decal for a period determined by the administration

Any student who parks in the student parking lot without a decal will receive a parking ticket. Habitual violators of this rule will face additional consequences.
