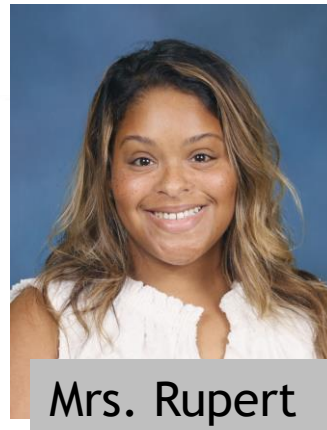

Security Procedures

1. **Entering at the Front Office: Ring door bell, provide your name, child's name and reason for visiting campus**
2. **Show photo ID using entry camera above doorbell**
3. **All visitors *MUST* sign-in and out in the Front Office and wear a Visitor's Pass**

General Reminders

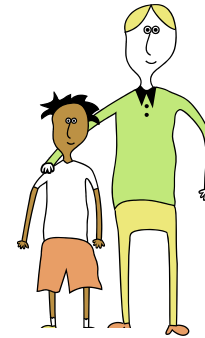
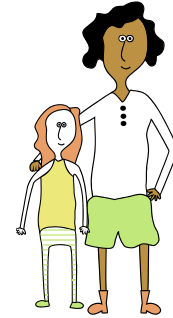
- Please use the front parking lot. School perimeter gates are locked during the day.

Afternoon Car Rider Line

Bus Riders

- Students are given a yellow bracelet with name and bus # on the first day of school. They will wear it the entire week.
- Upon arrival, students may go to breakfast or report to holding area. At dismissal students wait in holding area.
- Students are always supervised by PME staff and safety patrols.



Lunch

- Breakfast is free for students/**Lunch \$2.00**
Adult breakfast costs \$1.50/Lunch \$3.00
- **ALWAYS** send \$\$ in an envelope/baggie with child's first, last name.
- Best to pay by month on-line so there is money in your child's account.
- If packing lunch, plastic containers are recommended.



Playground

- Children need independent play at recess.
- Recess occurs DAILY before lunch.
- Visitors are not permitted at recess.
- Recommend tennis shoes with Velcro for younger students.



Communication with Teacher

- Teacher is willing to address all concerns through preferred methods of communication.
- Wednesday Folder contains all important district, school and class information.



Celebrations

Birthday Celebrations are special for all students, and each classroom teacher acknowledges a student's birthday in various ways. In all cases, children are recognized on their special day. If you wish to send in an item for your child's birthday, you may send in a non-food item that will be distributed at the end of the school day.
