Four nominees were on the ballot, with four SAC spots needing to be filled. All nominees were elected to SAC. John Gualdoni Chabely Marsh Christina Davidow Abby Cimato 2. Vote for Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary SAC Members voted to elect Christina Davidow as SAC Chair, Rebecca Stalek as SAC Vice Chair, and Brooke Vayda as Secretary. 3. 24/25 PME School Theme PME has voted to continue the 23/24 year theme of “Leaders are Built at PME” 4. PME Staff Allocations PME lost one instructional (teacher) allocation, and one non-instructional (support staff) allocation. These allocations are based on projected student enrollment by the school district. The lost allocation impacted third grade due to lower numbers. Third grade went from 7-6 teachers.
