APPROVAL OF MINUTES	A review and approval of the September SAC minutes by all members present.						
AGENDA ITEMS	<p>1. Budget The 24/25 SAC budget and accounts were explained and discussed. TLEADS- Money given by the state. Instructional employees are given money to help buy classroom supplies each year. Any left-over money that is not used by the teachers goes into this fund, that is rolled year to year. SHIMPER- school improvement money- this money is no longer given by the state. This account balance will NOT increase this year, nor did it last year. SCHREC- School recognition funds for being an “A” school. Staff can vote to give SAC 1 share, or part of a share, each year this recognition is received. Money for at least 1 share is always held in this account in case any staff member is accidentally left out of the monetary recognition for being an “A” school. If money accumulates past the 1 share, SAC can vote on how it is spent. It is anticipated that staff will not vote to have a share put into this account this school year. PME staff can write proposals for SAC to give them funds to use for students. Quarter 1 Benchmark -Science/ 5th grade only 5th grade participate in their first benchmark test, one of the preliminary test before the end of year state science test. 5th grade is the only grade to be state tested in science. These benchmark scores are used to guide teaching.</p> <p>3. Review of SAC Bylaws Each SAC member was presented with a copy of the SAC bylaws to review. These are reviewed each year by SAC and are also available to all parents on the PME website. SAC voted to remove an “or” on page 2 of the SAC bylaws to make the statement clearer.</p> <p>4. TLEADS Paper Proposal Last year the SAC committee approved a computer paper purchase for the PME staff members, but it was not able to be stored over the summer. This year SAC re-approved this proposal for paper. There was an approval for 55 cases of paper for \$2,199.45, \$39.99 per case.</p> <p>5. School Food Inquiry Some members of SAC are inquiring more about the food being served in the school cafeterias at CCPS.
