<p>AGENDA ITEM 2</p>	<p>New Business</p> <p>Review of Birthday/Celebration Policies- Survey Results</p> <p>A Collier County district policy already exists to guide our wellness policy and classroom celebrations. In order to be compliant with this policy, the wellness committee has proposed an updated birthday and celebration policy for Pelican Marsh Elementary school. A survey was sent out to ask for feedback on the new policy.</p> <p>Cheryl Malick went over the survey results. The Pelican post was sent out via email to 460 unique email addresses. Of those 460 email addresses, 255 people opened up the email. Of those 255 people, 103 opened up the survey and 50 of those people responded with feedback.</p> <p>Dr. Barcellino spoke about how these policies are about encouraging healthy choices and supporting the teachers and families. A discussion among the SAC members followed.</p> <p>The majority of the SAC committee is in agreement with the new birthday and celebration policy.</p>
<p>AGENDA ITEM 3</p>	<p>Blue Zone</p> <p>We welcomed Marie Irwin and Joe Stoner as coordinators of CCPS human resources, benefits and wellness programs.</p> <p>Marie Irwin and Joe Stoner both spoke about their global district Blue Zone perspective. According to the district wellness policy, schools in the district are complying with the Florida Administrative code as well as Collier County School District’s Wellness Policy. Therefore, we are moving away from using food for rewards and/or birthday celebrations. Many CCPS schools have already met qualifications to be healthy, Blue Zone schools. Nutrition services are using only FDA-approved healthy snacks.</p> <p>PME has already implemented many healthy habits. Among those healthy habits are the health and wellness council, Walking Wednesdays, and the school garden. Considerations for next year include having recess before lunch. Deena Folz talked about the success of the garden.</p> <p>Joe Stoner and Marie Irwin spoke about supporting and empowering both the parents and the children. They emphasized how becoming a Blue Zone school is a completely voluntarily.</p>
