Mike Davis Elementary Dress Code / Uniform

- **Bottoms**- Navy blue or tan walking shorts (knee-length) or pants. Girls may also wear navy blue or tan knee-length skirts, skorts, or jumpers. No jeans or sweat pants.
- **Shirts**– Polo-style with collar, any solid color (logos and/or labels must be no larger than 2” and shirt must have no more than 4 buttons)
- **Dresses/Jumpers**—Navy or tan only
- **Shoes**– Sneakers only. Shoes must be laced and tied or have a Velcro closure. No light up shoes!
- **Socks**– Socks must be worn and can be any color.
- Clothing must be clean, free from holes and fringe, and fit properly.

All students, Kindergarten through 12th grade, NEW or returning to the District, must be registered using the Online Centralized Registration system.

School begins August 12, 2020. We strongly encourage you to register your child(ren) during the months of May and June.

Avoid delays later in the summer.

- If a student must leave early for an appointment or emergency, what are the procedures for this?

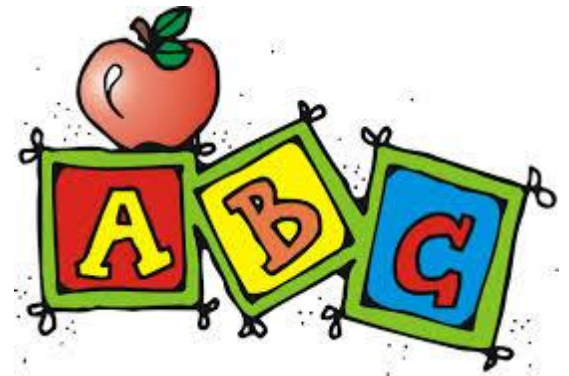

Lunch Procedures

- What is the procedure at school for parents joining students for lunch? Parents must check-in with the front office using proper identification and sit at the designated family lunch table with the student.
- All lunch money must be in an envelope, clearly marked with your child's name, lunch number and teacher's name on the outside.

- **STEP ONE: Complete the Online Registration:**

- Complete the online volunteer application at <https://www.collierschools.com/Volunteer> Complete and SUBMIT your application.

- **STEP TWO: Contact School:**

- Call the school you wish to volunteer for and schedule an orientation with the volunteer contact.

- **STEP THREE: Schedule Appointment:**

- Schedule an appointment with Human Resources for Level II fingerprinting. An authorization form from the school is required. **Be sure to follow up with your school within 5-7 business days for status updates*

- Label your child's belongings.
- Velcro Shoes
- Read to your child every night.
- Teach your child how to recognize his/her name.
- Make sure your child can use the bathroom independently.



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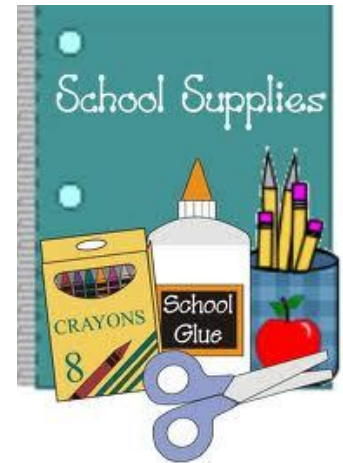
- Independent Dressing Issues
- Have your child practice opening the containers for lunch.
- Help them learn their address and phone number.
- Practice using scissors and glue.
- Have them practice using their letters and numbers.
- Help them learn how to hold a pencil correctly.



Supplies

Always appreciated:

- 1 large backpack (NO rolling backpacks-please)
- 2 boxes of 24 count Crayola brand crayons (1 box per quarter)
- 2 packs 24 count No. 2 pencils (sharpened)
- 1 pair of Little Fiskar brand metal scissors with a rounded tip
- 2 packs of Large Elmer Glue sticks
- 3 Mead brand composition books (1-red, 1-green, 1-purple)
