Aubrey Rogers High School Parking Application 2023-2024

Welcome to Aubrey Rogers High School!

Student parking at ARHS is limited and assigned on a first come first serve basis. Purchasing a student tag for parking is a privilege that must be earned and maintained. **All students who desire to park on campus are required to purchase a parking permit tag.** To purchase the parking tag, the student must have a valid Florida driver's license, a current ARHS student ID and a current Florida vehicle registration for each vehicle that will be linked with that tag (limit to two vehicles per tag). Parking tags may be purchased at a cost of \$25.00 each. These will be valid for the entire school year. As we prepare to assign parking spaces for the upcoming school year, please take a few minutes to review the information below and complete the provided online FORM using the link/QR code. **Tags must be in place, hanging from the rear-view mirror at all times, while on campus, in order to avoid disciplinary action.**

The dates below have been assigned by grade level for students to select their parking spaces, please note students will be able to choose specific spaces on a first come first serve basis on the following dates from **8:00 am to 12:00pm.**

- **August 7th, 2023- Seniors Only**
- **August 8th, 2023- Juniors Only**
- **August 9th, 2023- Eligible Sophomores- Any upper-level classmen that missed Monday/Tuesday.**

Parking privileges of any student may be revoked for the following reasons:

- Parking without a valid tag.
- Operating a vehicle in an unsafe manner.
- Parking in a spot not assigned to you, including visitor, teacher, or handicapped spot.
- Parking on the grass.
- Loitering in parked cars before or after school.
- Exceeding the posted speed limit.
- Going to your car without a pass from the Attendance/Discipline Office during the school day.
- Excessive tardiness to school.
- Zero tolerance suspensions (especially as related to drugs).
- Excessive truancy.
- Tampering, copying, or modifying a parking tag in any way.
- Using another student's parking tag.

Note: Students should notify the Attendance/Discipline Office within one week after changing vehicles or license plates.
