EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The District is required to schedule and perform inspections and maintenance of approximately six thousand (6,000) fire extinguishers and fifty-eight (58) kitchen fire suppression systems located throughout the district. New extinguishers and equipment are also purchased on an as-needed basis, as determined by the Security & Safety Department. Staff recommends approval of purchase from Dyna Fire Inc., of Fort Myers, Florida, as the sole bid received. A solicitation was conducted and posted for twenty (20) days, with approximately 114 vendors notified and 33 vendors receiving a copy of the solicitation. The recommended vendor submitted documentation, has successfully serviced the district, and has met all requirements to provide services to the District. All pricing is considered fair and reasonable. The initial contract will be for a 2-year period from July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2025. The estimated annual exposure for each year is in the amount of \$200,000.00, for a total estimate for the 23-24 and 24-25 school years in the amount of \$400,000.00.
