**Program Details:** See above calendar for dates, times and specific activities for the session week you are enrolled in

- This is an abbreviated and accelerated program, not a required course – this program requires students to be highly motivated, comfortable with technology on their own and able to schedule structured time for the required online content as well as ability to attend the 16 hour program week of activities they are assigned (Blue Team or Green Team)
- Students who have completed final registration and attended the workshop will be enrolled and taught how to access and navigate in the required online content during the required workshop on May 16<sup>th</sup>. Angel content will be accessible beginning on May 27<sup>th</sup> to final registrants
  - The 14 online content hours will be accessible for completion for the 36 students on the **BLUE Team from May 27<sup>th</sup> through June 14<sup>th</sup>**, all content must be completed for this group prior to beginning Behind-the-Wheel (BTW) program on June 15<sup>th</sup>
  - The 14 online content hours will be accessible for completion for the 36 students on the **GREEN Team from May 27<sup>th</sup> through June 21<sup>st</sup>** to be completed in order for them to begin the BTW program starting on June 22<sup>nd</sup>
- Students who sign up for this program offering will need to have access to computer and the internet, either at home, local library or another source
- In order for the certificate of completion to be received at the end of program, and the opportunity to complete driver test for DMV waiver:
  - Students must be on site for the 16 scheduled hours and have 75% on all exams, content projects and activities required
  - Students do not have to take or pass the driver test to receive the certificate of completion for 30-hour program
- Student also must have their own transportation to and from GGH for the 4-day program; adhering to required times
- A certified CCPS instructor and certified Driver Education Licensing Administrator (DELAP)-Third Party Tester will review student work completed and evaluate the progress of online content. Student work must stay at 75% or above to get behind the wheel access for the safety and consistency of all students in the program

**Registration Process:**

- There will be 36 student seats available on the **Blue Team (June 15<sup>th</sup> – June 18<sup>th</sup>)** and another 36 seats on the **Green Team (June 22<sup>nd</sup> – June 25<sup>th</sup>)**
  - Preference for which 4-day session will be considered during registration process, although may not be available
- Pre-registration form can be picked up after Spring Break in the school counselors welcome area or printed at <http://www.collierschools.com/driverseducation> beginning March 17<sup>th</sup>. The pre-registration form must be filled out completely and legibly and accompanied by a copy of the students permit dated April 9<sup>th</sup> or earlier
- This program is a first come first served; registration begins on March 23<sup>rd</sup> at 7am with the school counselor's secretary, and ends once filled or April 9<sup>th</sup>
- Registration will occur live at school site through school counselor's secretary by registering for a seat by entering student information into a live/real-time document. It is advised that a parent/guardian be there for registration in case a preferred time slot is filled
  - Students will not be permitted to be late for class to register for this summer program
  - Registration should take approximately 3 minutes per student but wait time for registration will be determined by how many people will be in line to register at all schools across the district – you may wish to check office hours ahead of time
  - There is a chance that seats will be filled quickly and there are no guarantees for seats, we will hold a 6 person waitlist in case students cancel their registration prior to start
- **A parent/guardian and their enrolled student will be required to attend the mandatory Presentation Workshop on Saturday, May 16<sup>th</sup> @ Barron Collier HS from 8:30-10:00 am** doors will open at 8 am to check in 8:30 presentation begins – Students will be in Auditorium; Parents in Media Center – Directions for online access portion will be provided then
