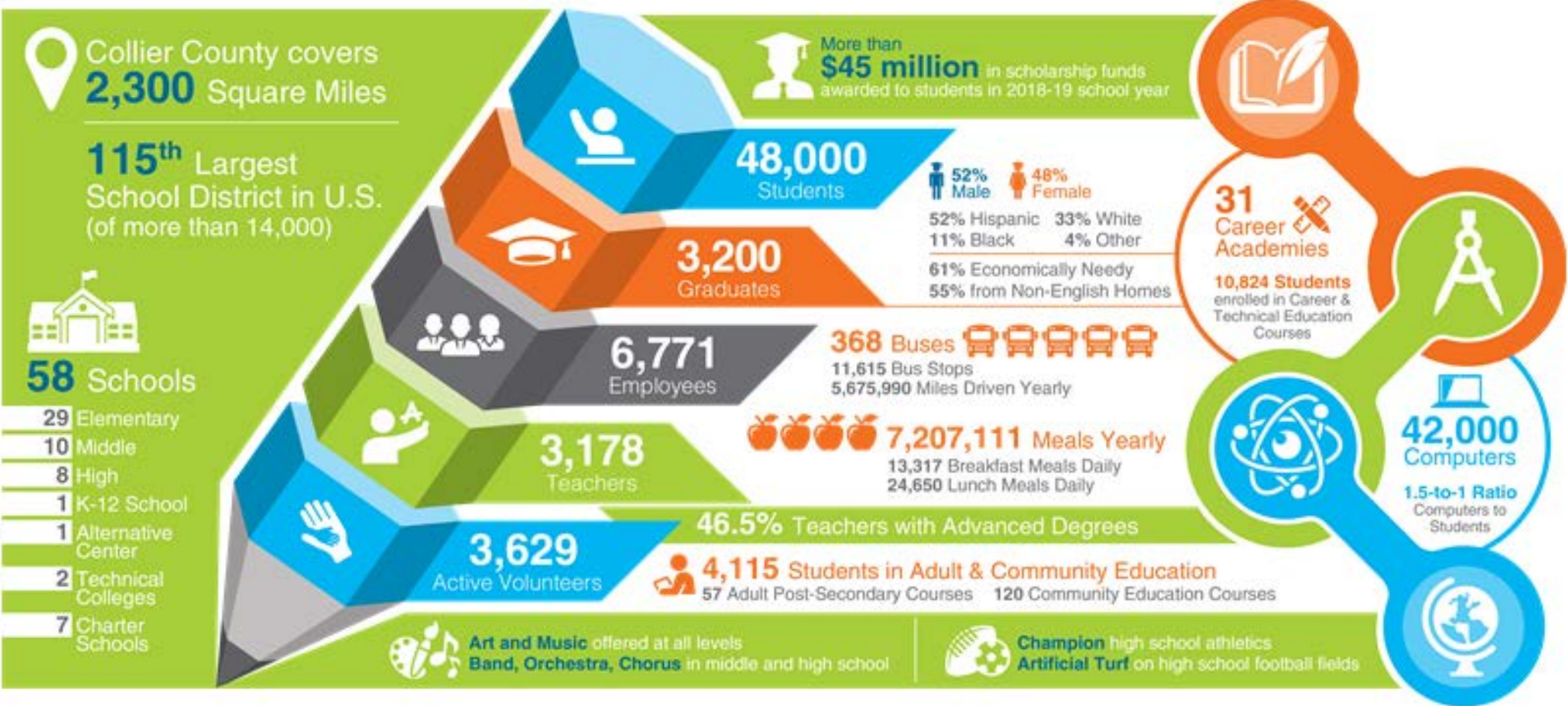

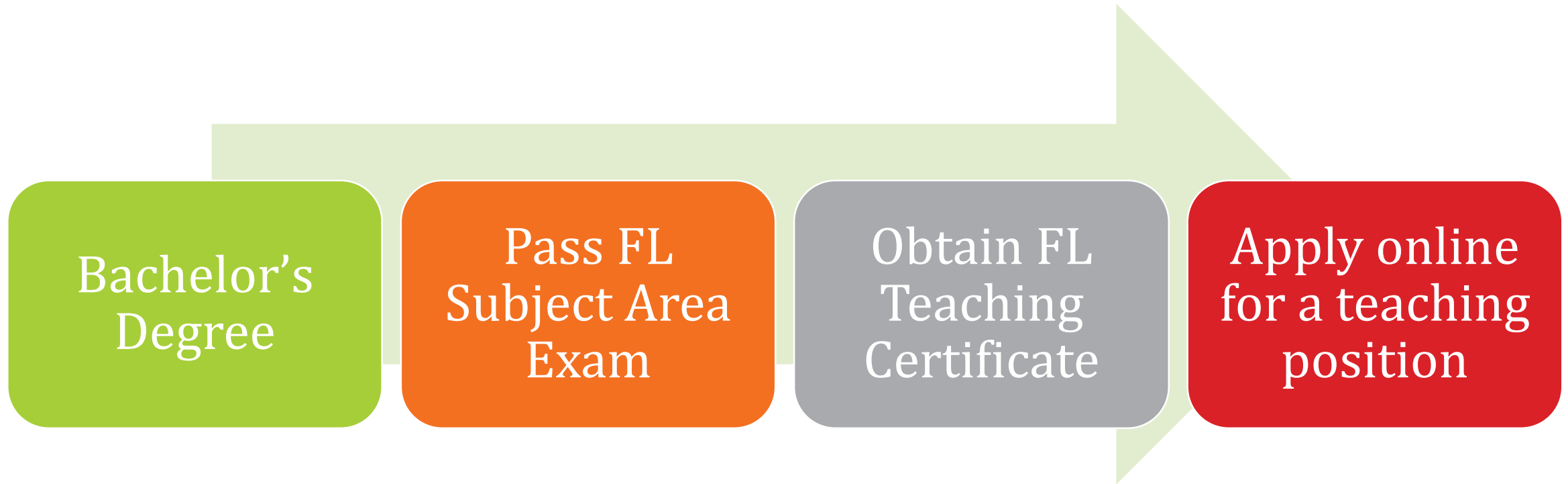

How to become a teacher for CCPS



The route to becoming a teacher requires education and certification.

By following your Florida's alternative certification route, you can become a teacher as part of a career change.



Certification Tips

Temporary Certification

- Only issued AFTER you are hired as a teacher
- Valid for 3 years
- Non-renewable

Requirements to move to a Professional Certificate

- General Knowledge Exam (4 subtests)
- Professional Education Test
- Professional Education Competence Program*
- Education Courses – 15 semester hours
- Offered through the new Professional Development Certification Program
- Practical Teaching Experience – 1 year of full-time teaching*
