**SY18 Grades 3-10 Florida Standards Assessment (FSA),
Florida Standards End-of-Course-Exam (EOC), and Next
Generation Sunshine State Standards (NGSSS)
Spring Assessment Results**

The Florida Department of Education (FDOE) released spring assessment results for schools across the state. We are proud of the many school and overall District improvements.

The content mastered by students in these areas is critical to ensuring that our students have the knowledge and skills they need in their pathways toward becoming College and Career Ready. We are encouraged by the achieved improvements and how they translate into potential for success in rigorous courses. We appreciate all of the hard work and perseverance of our students, teachers, parents, administrators, District staff, and strong community support.

- The District outperformed the State in 19 of 21 assessed areas
- Grades 3, 4, 5, and 6 outperformed the State in all areas
- All tested areas of science again increased for CCPS year-to-year with students scoring at level 3 or higher inclusive of 5th NGSSS (+4 from 2017 to 2018), 8th NGSSS (+5 from 2017 to 2018), and Biology (+4 from 2017 to 2018).
